The standard Limousine-cab licence conditions

- (1) Subject to the provisions of condition (2) below, this licence may only be used by the holder, personally or through the intermediary of employees of the holder. Neither the licence nor the use or benefit thereof may be leased, licenesed, assigned, or otherwise transferred to any third party, whether permanently or temporarily. No payment may be required or recieved by the holder for allowing any person to use the vehicle to which this licence relates for the provision of a public vehicle service.
- (2) If the holder wishes, for the purpose of providing a public vehicle service on a specific occasion to engage a holder of a public service driver's badge who is not an employee of the holder (hereinafter called the "driver") to drive the vehicle to which this licence relates, the holder shall ensure that the driver is engaged on terms which require the driver to be under the direction and control of the holder.
- (3) The vehicle to which this licence relates shall only be used to provide a pre-booked or contractual service
- (4) No fare shall be paid to the driver of the vehicle at the time when the service is provided.
