If no application has been made for the engagement of Registered and/or Licenced staff, the provisions of the Law relating to the recruitment of staff strictly apply, and should you wish to engage Registered and/or Licenced staff at a future date, a further application would be required.

A person carrying on an undertaking shall provide to the Minister, when required to do so by a notice served on him or her by the Minister, a statement of the name and current residential and employment status of such persons working in or for the undertaking during such period as the Minister may specify in the notice and such other particulars relating to such persons as the Minister may determine.

Any change of Place of Business or Registered Business or Correspondence address should be notified to the Population Office within **14 days**.

Residential Status	Definition	Residential	Employment
Entitled	Someone who has lived in Jersey for 10 years OR who is granted this status on hardship or on social or economic grounds	Someone who can purchase or lease any property and occupy that property OR otherwise let it out OR leave vacant, subject to any conditions	Someone who can work anywhere, OR start their own business
Licensed	Someone who is an 'Essential Employee' engaged by a specific business with permission to engage such a person	Someone who can purchase or lease any property so long as they occupy that property and maintain their Licensed status	If an employer has a business licence on which a condition is attached, enabling them to employ a licensed person for a specific role
Entitled to Work Only	Someone who has lived in Jersey, continuously, for 5 years, or is the spouse of someone who is Entitled, Licensed, or Entitled for Work Only	Someone who can lease Registered Property for their own occupation <i>OR</i> Someone who can buy Qualified Property jointly with their Entitled spouse <i>OR</i> Someone who can occupy property with an Entitled person, in so far as the Entitled person occupies the substantial portion of the property	Someone who can work anywhere, OR start their own business
Registered	Someone who does not qualify under the above categories	Someone who can lease Registered Property for their own occupation <i>OR</i> Someone who can occupy property with an Entitled person, in so far as the Entitled person occupies the substantial portion of the property	Someone for whom an employee needs a Registered licence

30 (1) A Licence granted under Article 26 may be **revoked** by the Minister, under Article 30, by giving notice in writing to the licence holder -

(a) if the Minister is satisfied that:

- i. any information provided in connection with the application for the licence, or an application to vary the licence, was false or misleading in a material particular,
- ii. There has been failure to comply with any condition of the licence,
- iii. In the case of a business licence only, the undertaking has ceased to exist or appears to have ceased to exist (whether or not the licence holder or the undertaking has been wound up or dissolved)
- iv. The licence is significantly detrimental to the interests of Jersey having regard to the factors specified in Article 26(9), or
- v. The undertaking has failed to pay an annual charge under Article 31 or has failed to submit statements as required under Article 32: or

(b)

- i. If the licence holder requests or agrees to the revocation of the licence.

A person who knowingly or recklessly provides information under any Article of this Law, such information being false or misleading in a material particular shall be guilty of an offence and liable to imprisonment for a term of 2 years and to a fine.
