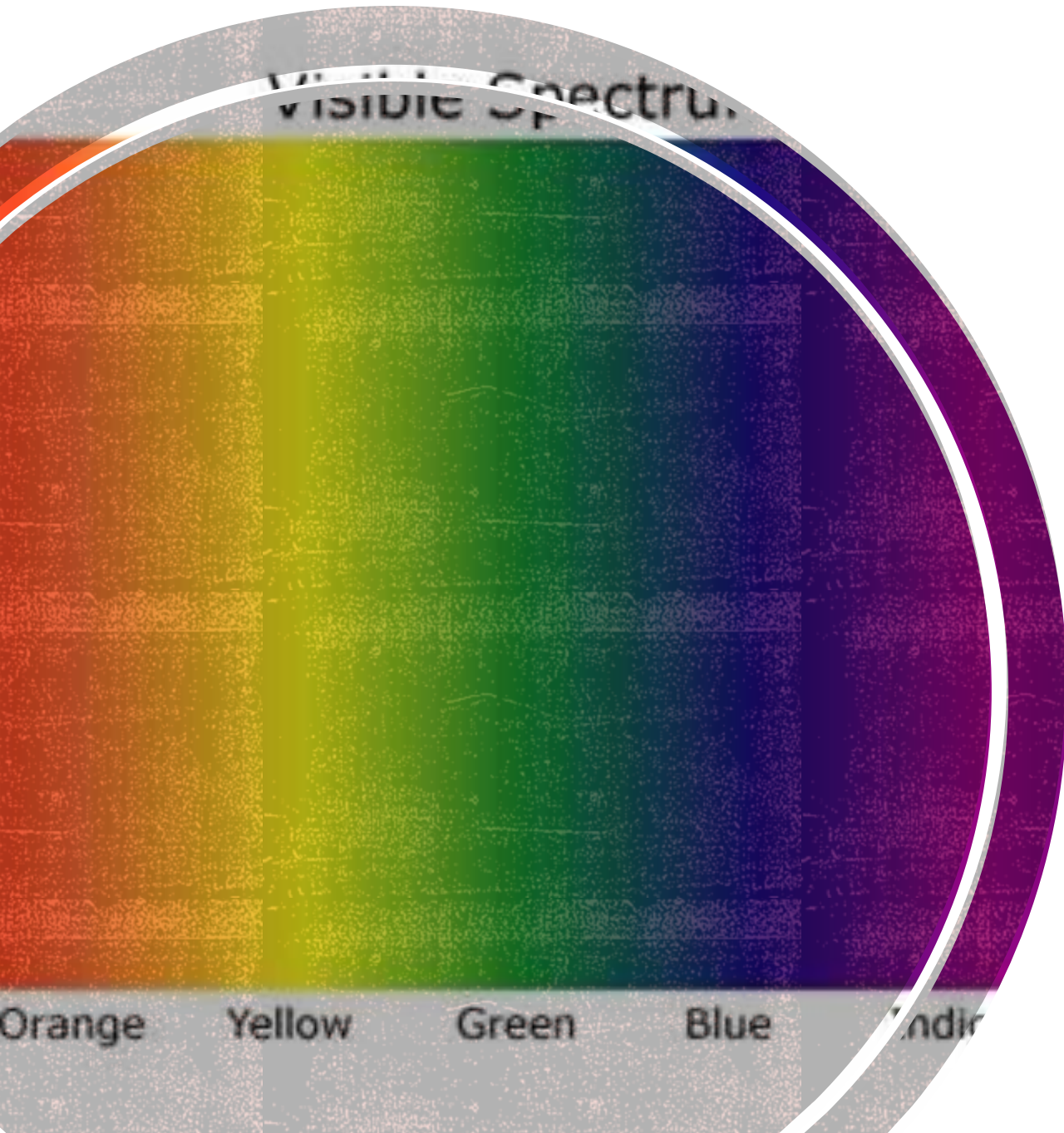

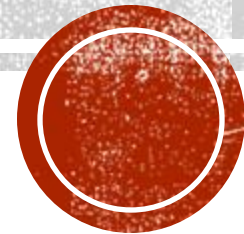
WHY IS IT IMPORTANT TO BE AWARE OF SEXUAL DIVERSITY?
