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	Parish Engagement
	It was pointed out that St Clement's Parish Hall has created an engaged
	community of volunteers that assist parishioners with various tasks. The
	forum felt that all parishes would greatly benefit from this model.
	To Action: Invite Connétable to a meeting to discuss how to engage all
	parish halls within their communities.
	The list will be continually reviewed, and any additional suggestions are
	welcomed throughout the year.
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	It was discussed that an individual is unable to receive a carers allowance
	and a pension at the same time. The forum members feel this is unfair. A
	member of the forum will be attending a carers meeting in November which
	will be joined by the Social Security Minister where this issue will be raised.
	<b>To Action:</b> Forum member to update the forum on discussion with Minister
	regarding pension and carers allowance.

	The forum felt it was not necessary for Jersey Sport/Move More to present at the forum. A forum member let the group know that to attend any Move More classes you must be referred by a GP.
	The forum also discussed how to attract more members to the meetings. Leaflets and posters at the library and parish halls were suggested as well as advertisements in parish magazines and on the radio.

	The forum discussed the rise in businesses using QR codes on advertisements without any further contact information. Individuals who do not have smart phones or who are not confident using technology have difficulty using QR codes. The forum would like to raise awareness so that businesses continue to use contact numbers or email addresses as well as QR codes.  To Action: Chair to contact the Customer Feedback Team (Government of Jersey) to highlight the need to use contact numbers and email addresses as well as QR codes.

	A member of the forum brought up the closure of various customer facing businesses including the Lloyds bank in St Brelade and the pharamacy in St Clement. Many businesses are now only contactable through online channels, or require travel to town for face-to-face communication, which can pose challenges for individuals with mobility issues or those without access to a car. The Chair informed the forum that the Minister had spoken with Lloyds Bank regarding the closure of their St Brelade branch, however, he was unable to effect any changes to the situation.  To Action: Chair to investigate alternative measures put in place for the closure of the Lloyds branch in St Brelade.  To Action: Chair and forum member to investigate alternative measures for the closure of the St Clement's pharmacy.
