	The members of the forum introduced themselves and the Chair reviewed the general housekeeping of the meeting so that the forum was accessible to everybody.

	Representatives from Corbett Le Quesne joined the forum to share information on capacity and lasting power of Attorney (LPA). Please see the attached information provided by Corbett Le Quesne below.
	You can access the LPA form online free of charge, alternatively, you may reach out to a law firm for assistance with the online form, however this will incur a fee. It was discussed that the form to appoint an LPA is only available

	online, which poses challenges for individuals who do not have access to the internet. The form also has a time limit and cannot be saved for later completion. The forum members felt there should be multiple options to access the form.

	The Minister for Infrastructure joined the meeting to update the forum on blue badge parking.
	An 8% increase in the amount of blue badge spaces has been implemented, adding 16 new spaces. Three additional spaces will be introduced in Library Place by mid-2025, with plans for additional spaces in New Street. The Minister let the forum know that there are plans to paint blue badge spaces blue, as research indicates that this reduces the instances of space misuse.
	All blue badge holders will receive a survey to better understand their needs and a focus group for blue badge users is being considered to enhance user experience.
	The Minister is proposing regulations for e-bikes exceeding 15 mph to require number plates and insurance, additionally riders must wear helmets. The

	Minister confirmed that it is illegal for bicycles and e-bikes to cycle on pavements unless explicitly permitted by signage.
	A forum member raised concerns about the safety of the pedestrian crossing on the cycle track at St Aubin's Bay, as they have experienced bikes and e- scooters speeding through. The Minister is considering measures to enhance visibility and safety at this crossing.
	A forum member informed the Minister that they have noticed discrepancies in 'fit to drive' assessment requirements across different parishes. The Co- Chair was advised by the Minister to contact the Comité des Connétables to ask for clarification and standardised requirements for the 'fit to drive' assessment.
