Chief Statistician - Statistics Jersey discontinuance of statistical reports

Statistics Jersey's share of Cabinet Office budget reductions means reductions to existing outputs are necessary. Statistics Jersey have reprioritised our work and outputs to focus on those we understand to be of greatest value to users such as: the Retail Price Index; Average Earnings; the House Price Index; Labour Market data; GDP estimates; the Jersey Children and Young Persons Survey and Island Outcome Indicators (Jersey's sustainable wellbeing indicators).

Statistics Jersey will stop producing the following outputs:

- Business Tendency Survey last report will be Q3 2024 (published 16 October 2024)
- Actively Seeking Work (ASW) last report was for Q2 2024 (published 10 July 2024)
- Note that CLS already publish ASW data as open data annually <u>Back to Work Statistics</u> -<u>Back to Work - Registered ASW Total - Government of Jersey Open Data</u>, and have agreed to do so quarterly going forward along with pre-announcing publication dates
- Energy Trends last report was for 2023 (published 7 August 2024)

As required by the <u>STATISTICS AND CENSUS (JERSEY) LAW 2018 (jerseylaw.je)</u> I have sought the advice of the Statistics Users Group on the discontinuance of these statistical reports.

The statistics release calendar <u>Statistical publications (gov.je)</u> includes Statistics Jersey's statistical reports up to December 2025. The release calendar has been updated to remove outputs that Statistics Jersey will no longer produce.

After 2025, the Jersey Opinion and Lifestyle Survey (JOLS) will be carried out every two years, alternating with the Children and Young Persons Survey, which already runs every two years. There will therefore be no Jersey Opinion and Lifestyle Survey in 2026.
