Common Strategic Policy 2024-2026 (P.21/2024)

It was noted that no amendments had been lodged to this proposition at the current time, but would be circulated to Ministers as and when received; and

Assisted Dying (P.18/2024)

Ministers were advised that they would be free to vote with their conscience on this proposition and that an amendment had been lodged ‘*au Greffe*’ on 7th May 2024 by the Assisted Dying Review Panel.
