The independent advisory panel's role

An independent advisory panel ('the Panel') was set up to oversee the planning for the Jury and ensure the integrity of the process. The members of the Panel are:

The Panel met 5 times prior to the start of the Jury sessions and acted as official observers for each of the 10 Jury meetings and the additional feedback session (with 1 - 2 panel members present at each session).
