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### **Animal Health (Importation of Miscellaneous Goods and Animals) (Jersey) Order 2017**

Application for Importation of Live Fish, Live Bivalve Molluscs, Eggs & Gametes

A person importing live fish, live bivalve molluscs, eggs or gametes under the Animal Health (Importation of Miscellaneous Goods and Animals) (Jersey) Order 2017, Article 2(1)(b) must be in possession of a licence granted by the Minister or person appointed by the Minister to import into Jersey. To apply for an import licence, you will be required to supply your Aquaculture Production Business (APB) Authorisation number issued under the EU legislation (Aquatic Animal Health) (Jersey) Regulations 2016

You are advised to check with your supplier that they are not under any restriction by the competent authority for any diseases.

An officer may, refuse an application and by notice in writing, vary, revoke or suspend any import licence issued.

Please allow at least 5 working days for processing.

The Importer shall comply with the following conditions and any others included in any licence issued to import:

1. The animal health and welfare section of the department must be notified using the online notification form\* of the exact date and time of import, at least one working day prior to arrival. If the arrival time changes after notification the duty officer can be contacted out of office hours on 01534 441617.

\* For imports from the British Islands you can complete the pdf form which we can provide.
2. All expenses incurred with this importation must be met by the importer.

3. If for any reason this licence is not used within the 1 month from the date of issue, it should be returned to the Department
