



Bus Stop Improvements 2024 Consultation Report



In December 2023, the Infrastructure and Environment (I&E) department consulted on proposals to install bus shelters and undertake accessibility improvements at a number of bus stops around Jersey. This report summarises the responses.

A new bus shelter was proposed at the following locations:

- Beaumont (2748), La Route de la Haule, westbound, St. Peter
- Greve d'Azette (2342), La Grande Route de la Cote, eastbound, St Clement
- La Hocq Slipway (2954), La Grande Route de la Cote, eastbound, St Clement
- La Motte Street (2867), La Motte Street, southbound, St Helier.
- Parcq du Rivage (3429), La Route de la Haule, westbound, St. Lawrence
- Trinity Arms (4645), La Rue es Picots, eastbound, Trinity
- Six Roads (3728), La Rue, eastbound, St. Lawerence




The location proposed at the Six Roads site was recently approved to be included in the 2024 consultation report. Negotiations with the adjacent land owner and the Parish of St. Lawrence have developed to a point where we are confident an installation can be achieved in 2024, therefore no public response information was collected regarding the site.

The following table examines the frequency of passenger traffic at six of the seven proposed bus stops. The average monthly passenger count has been extracted and presented, to indicate that each bus stop has sufficient demand to justify a bus shelter installation.

The Trinity Arms eastbound bus stop's passenger information does not appear in this data set because this a recently installed bus stop, that hasn't yet been updated into the Liberty Bus system. Therefore, no passenger or ticket transaction data is available at this location. Data was only selected from the years 2019 and 2023, to isolate and examine only information not affected by the disruption caused by COVID-19.



The discrepancy between the monthly passenger count at La Motte Street for the 2019 and 2023 data, can be attributed to significant disruption to that service throughout the year caused by road closures in that area. When the roadworks around the area are completed, the passenger count number is predicted to return to similar levels recorded in 2019. It may even



increase because of the number of residential developments completed during this time, creating a surge of new dwellings around this stop.

Following the feedback received as part of this consultation, works will go ahead as per the consultation plans at the following sites:

- Six Roads (3728), La Rue, eastbound, St. Lawerence

As part of this consultation, the Infrastructure and Environment department has also received numerous suggestions for other sites that the public would like to see accessibility improvements and waiting shelters installed. These requests have been logged by the department, and their feasibility will be assessed in due course.
