Job specific outcomes

- Check and maintain the security of the service premises and its contents.
- To carry out the service cleaning on a daily basis as well as maintain grounds.
- To report and act upon any faults or damages.
- To carry out maintenance where applicable
- Liaise and arrange schedule for tradesmen/contractors and ensure necessary work is undertaken.
- Act as a fire marshal & First aider
- General porter duties such as the movement of furniture / equipment.
- Manual handling of heavy goods such as musical instruments and music resources.
- Cleaning and fixing of musical instruments
- Movement of all stock and deliver and return in transportation and various other resources for concerts/event, examinations and schools following GOJ policies and procedures.
- To work with a senior member of the management team to undertake health, safety and security inductions for all service users.
