I would like to personally thank you both for the support demonstrated to the JT/Ericsson partnership and network announcement made yesterday in Digital Jersey. Taking time out of your busy diaries and coming straight from what I am sure was a long day at the Council of Ministers speaks volumes and is hugely appreciated.

[REDACTED] two very serious risks were top of my agenda (related to Global Titles and 999) and I am pleased with the significant progress being made in dealing with both those matters. And while not quite over the line yet, it's clear to me that working openly and constructively with the Digital Policy Unit and Justice & Home Affairs, we are, as I say, making significant progress.

You might also recall me mentioning in a meeting we had a few months' ago that I was looking forward to dealing with those two serious risks and getting on the front foot in relation to network investments and the more positive impact that JT can have in relation to supporting government, industry and consumers of telecom services across our Island. That started with yesterday's announcement and I now look forward to quietly and diligently pressing forward with the network investments and working with all parties to ensure that Jersey benefits to the fullest extent possible from having brilliant telecom infrastructure.

Good afternoon everyone,

A few weeks ago on Connect, I shared in confidence that we had chosen [Ericsson](#) to install the next generation networks that will provide mobile and fixed line services for JT's networks across the Channel Islands, subject to final negotiation and agreement of contract.

Following on from that announcement, I'm now delighted to share that we officially signed a contract with Ericsson yesterday at a small ceremony in Digital Jersey, at which senior representatives from Ericsson, the JT Board and a number of Jersey politicians were present (including Chief Minister, Deputy Kristina Moore, and Deputy Chief Minister / Economic Development Minister, Deputy Kirsten Morel).

This is a cornerstone of our strategy and a really exciting prospect for our customers, so to get it across the line in the tight timescales and within the budget [REDACTED] is nothing short of phenomenal. From this point, we start the work to install and connect the new core networks (of which there will be 3, plus a further test core network) and, thereafter, the Radio Access Network (RAN) across all mobile sites in the Channel Islands. With Ericsson, we will also now be in a position to commence engaging with customers on the breadth of capabilities that this network will bring to the Channel Islands and far beyond.

To get us to where we are today a lot of people have worked very hard for over 18+ months and I want to thank every one of them for their commitment in reaching this monumentally important milestone; it's hugely appreciated.

Finally, thank you to the JT Board, chaired by [REDACTED], for the confidence shown in signing off what is the single most significant investment ever made in the history of telecommunications in the Channel Islands.
