CONFIDENTIAL - Some facts on the reported stampede of Russians to Jersey

Separating fact from fiction.

Interest in Russian nationals arriving in Jersey began in 2016 and since then there appears to be a high level of interest – both media and social – into Russians who are moving to Jersey and when.

The Government of Jersey's stated position on who is given 2(1)(E) permission is that we do not comment on individual cases. Who has been approved, where they come from, how much they are worth, what property they have bought and what they eat for breakfast are personal matters and we respect their privacy. With regard to onboarding we have a [very] robust vetting system in place, and sensitive cases of any sort and PEPs are immediately referred to the Chief Minister for guidance.

I would also mention that three applications were submitted) and one by
, as one can imagine, have	ve carried out extensive KYC as part of their on-
boarding processes.	

In all cases those approved have existing ties to Jersey whether through business or personal Trusts etc.

The criteria for 2(1)(E) residency is clearly laid out on www.locatejersey.com and on www.gov.je and the Control of Housing & Work Law and the Tax Law cover in detail the requirements and entitlements are clearly laid out. There are no deals to be done as suggested by some in the media. In recent weeks we have answered a number of FOI questions that seek to obtain personal information or information that could lead to identifying individuals and we have answered them according to policy procedures.
