This was the holding statement we agreed, to go from the CM -

"We reviewed our policies for claiming expenses last year, and I announced then that spending on travel of more than ?500 would be published regularly. This latest set of figures shows a reduction in the number of transactions of ?500 or more, which suggests that staff are being more selective about when to travel, and a reduction in total costs above ?500.

"While spending on travel and accommodation is a relatively small proportion of States spending (approximately half of one percent) we need to provide value for money, especially as we are asking departments to continue their programme of reform and restructuring."

## Response

The Freedom of Information (Jersey) Law 2011 came in to force in January 2015. Data is therefore only available from that date.

A + B

Each States of Jersey department has a dedicated point of contact or recipient for Freedom of Information requests (POCs). This role is in addition to other roles they perform.

Historically the only individuals employed solely to work on Freedom of Information requests have been located within the Central Freedom of Information Unit (the CFU). The CFU currently comprises one full time Senior Freedom of Information Officer and one part time Freedom of Information Officer.

The CFU is the request handling 'hub' for SOJ, providing the logging and tracking of all requests and the issuing of responses to applicants.

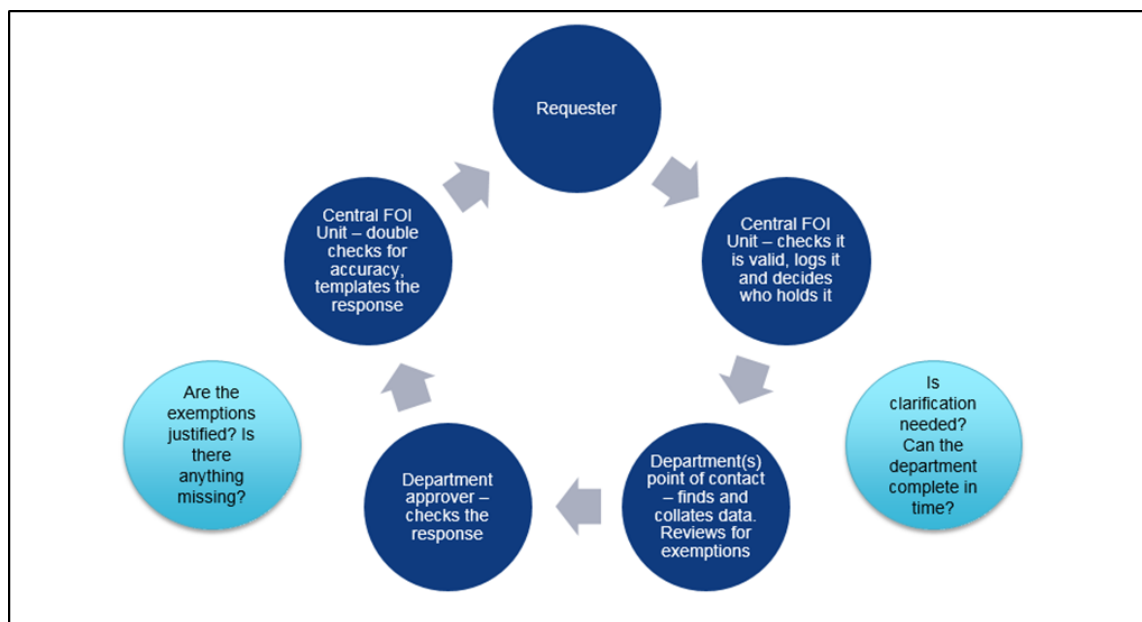
One member of staff, appointed in July 2018, does now work exclusively on Freedom of Information requests on behalf of the Chief Minister's Department and Treasury Department.

The CFU liaise with the POCs who arrange for the formulation of a response by those in the department who are best placed to provide the information.

The number of States of Jersey employees involved in a response will be dependent on the complexity of the request. Information on how many individuals are involved in preparing a response to a request is not held for each individual request.

Whilst there are only 2.5 staff employed solely to respond to requests, it falls upon existing staff within each States department to complete the requests.

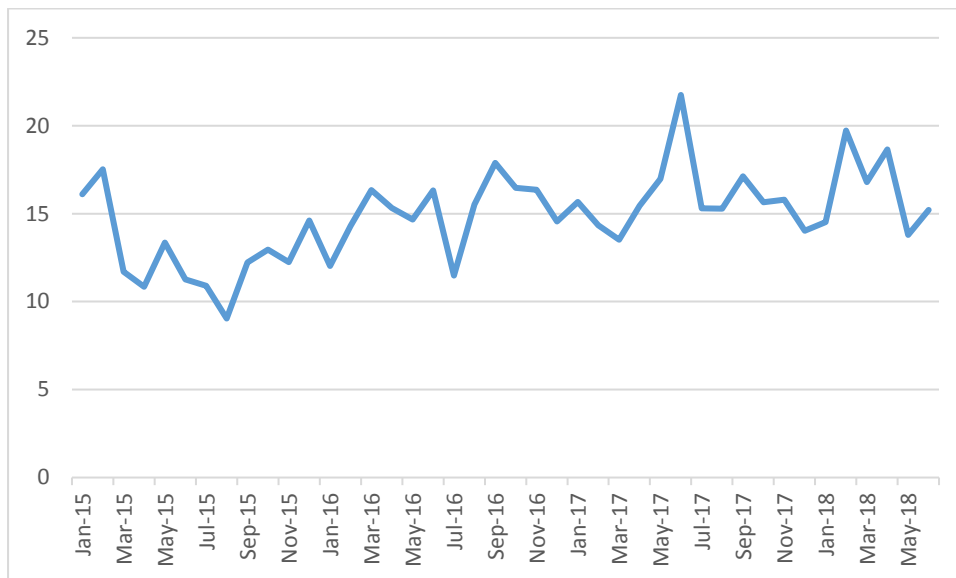

### **Request**

1. Is the expression "anti-Semitic" defined officially in Jersey and if so what is it?
2. Is this expression policed by any States or Parish organisations or departments and if so under what powers, laws or regulations?
3. If it is policed, have any actions or prosecutions arisen against any individuals, groups or organisation for anti-Semitic behaviour, speech or publication?

### **Response**

1. There is no legal definition of "anti-Semitic" in Jersey law. The government will consult on whether to adopt International Holocaust Remembrance Alliance's working definition of anti-Semitism alongside the consultation on legislation to address hate crime later in 2018.
2. As it is not defined, a definition of anti-Semitism it is not specifically 'policed'. However the Discrimination (Jersey) Law 2013 makes it unlawful to carry out direct or indirect discrimination because of a person's ethnicity. Further, engaging in threatening or abusive behaviour towards a person, whether on-line or in person, and whether or not involving physical harm, including because of a person's ethnicity or religious beliefs, may amount to an offence under customary law or statute. It would be for Employment and Discrimination Tribunal or the Courts to determine whether any unlawful or criminal act were motivated by anti-Semitism to the extent that is relevant to the determination of any proceedings.
3. As above, it is not.

The total cost incurred was £12,640. This consisted of:

- £2,890 for signage changes
- £9,750 for communications and marketing costs. This cost covered communicating to the public from the middle of September to the end of November, to inform them of the move of services to La Motte Street and the closure of customer services in other buildings. The costs covered leaflets and posters, three advertisements in the Jersey Evening Post, boosted social media posts and digital adverts, a three-week, 40-second radio advert on Radio 103 and an advert in the Parish Magazine – Our Island. There were no design costs, since all collateral was designed in house by the government Communications team.

- 2) Please confirm the total cost of moving the various States Departments to La Motte Street to deliver 'One Front Door'.**

The total cost incurred was £3,721. This consisted of:

- £2,333 for furniture and layout configuration costs – this included reconfiguration works to customer service desking and the fitting of cashier drawers
