Dear Deputy Lewis

The recycling facility in the West of the Island (at the entrance to Les Creux Country Park) is very well used, and has containers for cardboard, used batteries, paper, tin cans, plastic bottles and glassware.

It does not however have any place for light bulbs, and the only way to dispose of these properly is at the recycling centre, which has limited opening hours. While it is open at the weekend, driving in to town to deliver one light bulb (for example) seems excessively wasteful for petrol consumption, and adds extra traffic to the roads.

Might I suggest that a small container is placed at Les Creux for light bulbs, which would serve the western Parishes (St Brelade, St Peter, St Ouen) and make matters much easier.
