



Response to FOI request

Please note that we are only able to provide data relating to students registered with Student Finance, therefore Jersey students who attended University but did not register with Student Finance are not included in the data. In 2016 we plan to publish a report using data from UCAS (Universities and Colleges Admissions Service) and HESA (Higher Education Statistics Agency) which will include all students. We are unable to run reports which include numbers of students reading first degrees only, therefore the data relate to students studying both undergraduate and postgraduate courses.

Numbers of Jersey students in Higher Education by subject or group of subjects in the UK, EU, USA and elsewhere

In the academic year 2014/2015 there are 1,212 students registered with Student Finance studying a higher education course. Please see the following table for a breakdown of student numbers by subject group in 2014/2015:

Estimated financial outflow into UK and elsewhere, as a result of Jersey students studying in the UK and elsewhere: Fees, accommodation, travel and living costs In total 1,058 students registered with Student Finance are studying a Higher Education course off-island in 2014/2015. In 2014/2015 Student Finance awarded £6,969,919 in grants towards tuition fees and living expenses to Jersey students studying in the UK and elsewhere. We are unable to provide an estimate of additional financial outflow as a result of Jersey students studying off-island.
