

### **States of Jersey Law 2005 – Notification under Article 29A(3)**

Article 29A(3) of the States of Jersey Law 2005 requires the Chief Minister to present a report to the States for a 14-day period before making an Order to amend the name by which a Minister is described and/or to make provision relating to a Minister's functions (including their transfer from one Minister to another).

The Chief Minister intends to transfer legal responsibility for financial services from the Minister for External Relations and Financial Services to the Chief Minister. As a consequence, the title of the current Minister for External Relations and Financial Services would be amended to "Minister for External Relations".

Accordingly, this report appends a draft Order that would achieve this intention and commences a notice period of 14-days, after which the Order will be finalised and made.
