## **Appointment of Acting Official Analyst**

The Official Analyst gave notice of his retirement with effect from 5 June 2024. Recruitment for the Official Analyst role has commenced, and it is anticipated that a formal appointment will be made before the end of 2024. In the interim, the Principal Analyst is eligible to hold the office and has agreed to provide interim cover to ensure that the functions of the office continue to be performed.

The Official Analyst (Jersey) Law 2022, makes provision in Article 8 for the appointment of an Acting Official Analyst whilst there is a vacancy:

## 8 Acting Official Analyst

(1) The Minister may appoint an acting Official Analyst responsible for discharging the functions of the Official Analyst if the Official Analyst –

- (a) dies;
- (b) is incapacitated;
- (c) is suspended under Article 3(3);
- (d) has been dismissed under Article 3(1);
- (e) has resigned; or
- (f) is unable for any reason to discharge the functions of the Official Analyst.

(2) The appointment of an acting Official Analyst ends with the appointment of a new Official Analyst.
