### **Introduction**

- The Minister formally authorised that notification be given to the UK Department for Transport (DfT) of the closure of the Jersey Aircraft Registry, under the Aircraft Registration (Jersey) Law 2014.

### **Detail**

#### **Report (Public)**

The Jersey Aircraft Registry was established in 2015. Following a review by Officers in 2022, Ministers were advised that the JAR should close.

Officers need to inform the UK Department for Transport (DfT) of Jersey's decision to close the JAR.

Officers are also required to take necessary actions to effect the JAR's commercial and operational closure.

- The Minister therefore formalised, in accordance with the Aircraft Registration (Jersey) Law 2014, notification to the DfT of Jersey's intention to close the JAR and for Officers to take necessary further actions to effect the JAR's operational closure.
