ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT (2014 FEES) (JERSEY) ORDER 2013

Made

Coming into force

THE MINISTER FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, in pursuance of Articles 4 and 14 of the Places of Refreshment (Jersey) Law 1967, Articles 9 and 32 of the Tourism (Jersey) Law 1948 and Articles 12 and 38 of the Weights and Measures (Jersey) Law 1967, orders as follows –

1 Places of Refreshment (Registration) (Fees) (Jersey) Order 2008 amended

In Article 1 of the Places of Refreshment (Registration) (Fees) (Jersey) Order 2008, for the figure “£84” there is substituted the figure “£86”.

2 Tourism (General Provisions) (Jersey) Order 1990 amended

For Schedule 1 to the Tourism (General Provisions) (Jersey) Order 1990 there is substituted the following Schedule –

“SCHEDULE 1

(Article 21)

FEES FOR REGISTRATION OR RENEWAL OF REGISTRATION

Class of registration	Amount of fee
1. Hotel Register	£6.90 multiplied by the number of persons who can be lodged on the premises
2. Guest House Register	£4.61 multiplied by the number of persons who can be lodged on the premises
3. Self Catering Accommodation Register	£6.40 multiplied by the number of persons who can be lodged on the premises
4. Youth Hostel Register	£3.88 multiplied by the number of persons who can be lodged on the premises

5. Holiday Camp Register	£4.86 multiplied by the number of persons who can be lodged on the premises
6. Camp Site Register	£3.88 multiplied by the number of persons who can be lodged on the premises.”.

3 Weights and Measures (Testing Fees) (Jersey) Order 2003 amended

For the Schedule to the Weights and Measures (Testing Fees) (Jersey) Order 2003 there is substituted the following Schedule –

- (1) This Order may be cited as the Economic Development (2014 Fees) (Jersey) Order 2013.
- (2) Except as provided in paragraph (3), this Order comes into force on the seventh day after it is made.
- (3) Articles 1 and 3 come into force on 1st January 2014.
