Exemption of duty to register of a place of refreshment under Article 3 of the Places of Refreshment (Jersey) Law 1967.

In accordance with Article 3, Exemptions, of the Places of Refreshment (Jersey) Law, 1967, the Minister, in his or her absolute discretion, may exempt a place of refreshment from its duty to register under Article 2, Duty to Register, of the aforementioned Law.

On this occasion the Minister, taking into account the unique nature of the operation and business model employed by the undertaking, has decided to exempt 247 Vendkings Limited, t/a 24/7 Vend Store, of its duty to register as a place of refreshment under the Places of Refreshment (Jersey) Law, 1967.

This decision is effective as soon as the Ministerial Decision been made and may be revoked by Ministerial Decision.
