## Introduction

Officers supporting the Our Hospital Project Team are required to survey the relevant land for the purposes of preparing land contracts, giving effect to the decisions of the States Assembly with regard to compulsory purchase of the land identified as part of the Our Hospital Project (P.123/2020, P.129/2020, P.167/2020 and P.80/2021). Surveys are also required to develop proposals and discharge conditions associated with the draft Planning Approval.

# Recommendation

Officers to inform the Our Hospital Project Team of the Minister's decision.

## Detail

The Assistant Minister for the Environment has authorised power of entry under Article 122 of the Planning and Building (Jersey) Law 2002 to the officers supporting the Our Hospital Project Team for the purposes of preparing second notices to give effect to the decisions of the States Assembly with regard to compulsory purchase of the land identified as part of the Our Hospital Project (P.123/2020, P.129/2020, P.167/2020 and P.80/2021), if required.

Second notices are required to be served on the following properties:

Car Parking along Peirson Rd
Petanque Pitch Verge adjacent St Aubins Rd
Inn on the Park Car Park – car parking spaces (44 no) adjacent St Aubins Rd
People's Park Car Park – car parking spaces (69 no) including 2no bays for bicycles and motor bikes
Promenade including a section of playground adjacent to Westmount Road and attenuation tank
Land to the north of People's Park including walkway
Protected open space area utilised by Bowling Club
Protected open space to the south of upper Westmount Rd with steps on north east (1823m2)
Verge to the north of Jersey Bowling Club (1660m2)
Verge to the west of Westmount Rd (1570m2)
Protected open space (300m2) adjacent St John's Rd (Clos Vaze)
Near monument/Victoria Park (west)
Layby and Footway to the north of eastern end of Westmount Rd
Layby and footpath to the east of Overdale Hospital
Footpath and public realm between St Aubins Road and Victoria Avenue



Driveway, strip of land, bin store and raised planter at entrance to Hillcrest and Castle View owned by 5 Hillcrest, Westmount Road, St Helier JE2 3LP
