Detail

Following an appeal against the refusal of planning permission, reference RC/2024/0600, Sue Bell was appointed as the independent Planning Inspector to consider the appeal and all statements and other plans and documents associated with the appeal.

The Inspector visited the site and surroundings before preparing and submitting a report for the Minister's consideration. The Minister has decided to recuse himself from the decision making process in order to avoid a potential conflict of interest and has, accordingly, passed the appeal to the Assistant Minister for his determination.

The Assistant Minister has given full consideration to the appeal papers, Island Plan policies, supplementary planning guidance and to the Inspector's report.

Having considered all aspects of the appeal the Assistant Minister decided to give full effect to the Inspector's recommendation.

Decision

The Assistant Minister decided to allow the appeal and to approve the removal of condition no. 3 of planning permission P/2023/1310.

Reason for decision

The Assistant Minister agreed with the findings and reasoning of the Inspector.
