Following an appeal against the refusal of planning permission, reference P/2023/1371, Sue Bell was appointed as the independent Planning Inspector to consider the appeal and all statements and other plans and documents associated with the appeal.

The Inspector visited the site and surroundings before holding a hearing and, subsequently, preparing and submitting a report for the Minister's consideration.

The Minister has given full consideration to the appeal papers, Island Plan policies, supplementary planning guidance and to the Inspector's report.

Having considered all aspects of the appeal the Minister decided to give full effect to the Inspector's recommendation.
