Detail

Following an appeal against the refusal of retrospective planning permission at Rose Farm, Le Mont Cochon, St Helier (P/2024/0425), Sue Bell was appointed as the independent planning inspector to consider the appeal, including all plans and documentation associated with it.

The inspector visited the site and surroundings before holding a hearing and, subsequently, preparing and submitting a report for the Minister's consideration.

The Minister has given full consideration to the inspector's report and to the material factors referred to in it.

Decision

The Minister decided to dismiss the appeal, and that planning permission should be refused, in accord with the inspector's recommendation.
