

## EU LEGISLATION (SANCTIONS – SOUTH SUDAN) (AMENDMENT) (JERSEY) ORDER 2015

Coming into force

**THE MINISTER FOR EXTERNAL RELATIONS**, in pursuance of Article 2 of the European Union Legislation (Implementation) (Jersey) Law 2014, orders as follows –

## 1 EU Legislation (Sanctions – South Sudan) (Jersey) Order 2015 amended

- (1) The EU Legislation (Sanctions South Sudan) (Jersey) Order 2015 is amended in accordance with this Article.
- (2) In Article 1, for the definition "Regulation (EU) No 748/2014" there is substituted the following definition
  - "'Regulation (EU) 2015/735' means Council Regulation (EU) 2015/735 of 7 May 2015 concerning restrictive measures in respect of the situation in South Sudan, and repealing Regulation (EU) No 748/2014 (OJ L 117/13, 8.5.2015), as amended up to 9th May 2015 (subject to Article 2)."
- (3) for Article 2, there is substituted the following Article –

## **"2** Ambulatory references to Annexes

A reference in Regulation (EU) 2015/735 to any of the Annexes to that Regulation is to be read as a reference to such Annex as amended, substituted, extended or applied from time to time by any other EU provision, or as such Annex otherwise has effect in the EU from time to time by virtue of any judgment of the European Court."

- (4) In Article 3(2), for the words "(EU) No 748/2014" there are substituted the words "(EU) 2015/735".
- (5) In Article 4, in the heading and in both places where they occur, for the words "(EU) No 748/2014" there are substituted the words "(EU) 2015/735".
- (6) In Article 5 –

- (a) in paragraph (1)(a), for the words "11 of Regulation (EU) No 748/2014" there are substituted the words "15 of Regulation (EU) 2015/735";
- (b) in paragraph (2)(b), for the words "10 of Regulation (EU) No 748/2014" there are substituted the words "14 of Regulation (EU) 2015/735".

## 2 Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the EU Legislation (Sanctions – South Sudan) (Amendment) (Jersey) Order 2015 and comes into force on the day after it is made.
