### **Recommendation**

The Minister is recommended to approve the registration of Channel Island Recovery as a motor vehicle removal operator, in accordance with the provisions of the Motor Vehicles (Removal from Private Land) (Jersey) Regulations 2019.

### **Further Information**

An application has been made on behalf of Channel Island Recovery to register as a motor vehicle removal operator.

Article 7 of the Motor Vehicles (Removal from Private Land) (Jersey) Regulations 2019 (“the Regulations”) provides that the Minister must maintain and publish a register of motor vehicle removal operators.

Article 8 of the Regulations provides for the process to be followed for application for registration as a motor vehicle removal operator.

In accordance with Article 8 (2) of the Regulations if, upon receipt of an application, the Minister is satisfied that –

- a) the applicant has sufficiently secure premises to store any motor vehicle removed from private land;
- b) the applicant has a vehicle that is suitable for the safe removal of a vehicle from private land; and
- c) the applicant, if registered will have adequate insurance against any loss or damage to a motor vehicle removed by the applicant,

the Minister must register the applicant and provide him or her with a certificate of registration.

Channel Island Recovery is a professional vehicle recovery service. Based on the information contained with the application form they appear to meet the above requirements, with the correct insurance, equipment, and storage facilities.

The Minister is therefore recommended to approve the registration.
