ROAD RACING (FESTIVAL OF SPEED) (JERSEY) ORDER 2012

Made

Coming into force

THE MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND TECHNICAL SERVICES, in pursuance of Article 2 of the Motor Vehicle Races (Jersey) Law 1946, and on application of the Classic and Vintage Motor Racing Club of Jersey, orders as follows –

1 General provisions

- (1) This Order is subject to the Road Racing (General Provisions) (Jersey) Order 1959.
- (2) The promoters, for the purposes of that Order and this Order, are the Classic and Vintage Motor Racing Club of Jersey Limited.

2 Use of Five Mile Road course for sprints

- (1) Between 12 noon and 5.30 p.m. on 24th August 2012 the promoters may –
 - (a) use the Five Mile Road course for sprint races with motor vehicles, and for practices for those races; and
 - (b) for those purposes, close that course to traffic.
- (2) In paragraph (1) “Five Mile Road course” means –
 - (a) La Grande Route des Mielles (Route B.35) from its junction with Le Chemin des Basses Mielles to a point 75 yards south of La Carrière Quarry at La Pulente;
 - (b) the Gravel Car Park at La Pulente; and
 - (c) Les Brayes Car Park.

3 Use of Grève de Lecq course for hill climbs

- (1) Between 8.30 a.m. and 5 p.m. on 25th and 26th August 2012 the promoters may –

- (a) use the Grève de Lecq course for hill climbs with motor vehicles, and for practices for those races; and
 - (b) for those purposes, close that course to traffic.
- (2) In paragraph (1) “Grève de Lecq course” means –
- (a) Le Mont de Ste. Marie;
 - (b) La Rue Mahier from its junction with Le Mont de Ste. Marie to its junction with La Rue de la Ville au Neveu;
 - (c) La Rue de la Ville au Neveu from its junction with La Rue Mahier to its junction with Le Mont Vibert; and
 - (d) Le Mont Vibert.

4 Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Road Racing (Festival of Speed) (Jersey) Order 2012 and comes into force forthwith.
