SAND RACING (JERSEY) ORDER 2014

Made

Coming into force

THE MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND TECHNICAL SERVICES, in pursuance of Article 2 of the Motor Vehicle Races (Jersey) Law 1946, and on the application of the Jersey Motor Cycle and Light Car Club and after consultation with the Minister for Economic Development, orders as follows –

1 General provisions

- (1) This Order is subject to the Sand Racing (General Provisions) (Jersey) Order 1959.
- (2) The promoters, for the purposes of that Order and this Order, are the Jersey Motor Cycle and Light Car Club.

2 Use of Millbrook course for motor racing

- (1) In this Article “Millbrook course” means a part of the beach in St. Aubin’s Bay, to be determined by the promoters, within the area bounded –
 - (a) on the north by the sea wall;
 - (b) on the east by an imaginary line running from north to south and intersecting the sea wall at the boundary between the parishes of St. Helier and St. Lawrence;
 - (c) on the south by the sea; and
 - (d) on the west by an imaginary line running from north to south and intersecting the sea wall at the nearest point to the western side of Les Marais Avenue.
- (2) The promoters may use the Millbrook course for races, and practices for races, with motor vehicles, and may for those purposes close that course, between –
 - (a) 8.30 a.m. and 2.30 p.m. on 26th April 2014;
 - (b) 12.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. on 15th June 2014;
 - (c) 3.00 p.m. and 9.00 p.m. on 16th August 2014; and
 - (d) 8.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. on 6th September 2014.

3 Use of St. Ouen's Bay course for motor racing

- (1) In this Article "St. Ouen's Bay course" means a part of the beach in St. Ouen's Bay, to be determined by the promoters, within the area bounded –
 - (a) on the north by an imaginary line running from east to west and intersecting the sea wall immediately to the west of the junction of Route B.41 with La Grande Route des Mielles (Route B.35);
 - (b) on the east by the sea wall;
 - (c) on the south by an imaginary line running parallel to, and at a distance of 1600 yards to the south of, the imaginary line specified in sub-paragraph (a); and
 - (d) on the west by the sea.
- (2) The promoters may use the St. Ouen's Bay course for races, and practices for races, with motor vehicles, and may for those purposes close that course, between –
 - (a) 9.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. on 12th April 2014;
 - (b) 12.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. on 31st May 2014;
 - (c) 2.30 p.m. and 8.30 p.m. on 2nd August 2014; and
 - (d) 8.15 a.m. and 2.15 p.m. on 20th September 2014.

4 Use of West Park course for motor racing

- (1) In this Article "West Park course" means a part of the beach in St. Aubin's Bay, to be determined by the promoters, within the area bounded –
 - (a) on the north by the sea wall;
 - (b) on the east by an imaginary line running from north-east to south-west and intersecting the sea wall at the bottom of the slipway at West Park;
 - (c) on the south by the sea; and
 - (d) on the west by an imaginary line running from north-east to south-west and intersecting the sea wall at the top of the groyne nearest Tyneville Lane.
- (2) The promoters may use the West Park course for races, and practices for races, with motor vehicles, and may for those purposes close that course, between –
 - (a) 12.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. on 17th May 2014;
 - (b) 2.45 p.m. and 8.45 p.m. on 4th July 2014;
 - (c) 3.30 p.m. and 9.30 p.m. on 5th July 2014; and
 - (d) 10.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. on 26th July 2014.

5 Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Sand Racing (Jersey) Order 2014 and comes into force forthwith.
