Purpose of the Report

To obtain the Ministers approval for the installation of 2no. zebra crossings in St. John's Village.

Background

St John's Village Improvement Board (Parish representatives supported by Government's technical team) developed improvement options for the village which were presented at a community workshop in June 2023. A subsequent online consultation ran between August and October 2023.

A community workshop at the Parish Hall was well attended and an online consultation, promoted through a parish wide letter drop, received 204 responses. The feedback from parishioners was collated and steered towards several potential road safety interventions.

Conclusion

After listening to and acting upon community suggestions, an improvement scheme for 2024 has been finalised.

Two elements of the proposed scheme which require Ministerial approval are;

1. The installation of a zebra crossing on La Rue de la Mare Ballam adjacent to St. John's Parish Hall.

2. The installation of a zebra crossing on La Route du Nord by its junction with La Rue de l'Etocquet.



As it is on a key walking route for students of St. John's Primary School, it is intended to commence installation of the zebra crossing on La Rue de la Mare Ballam over the Autumn Half Term Holidays 2024.

The works on La Route du Nord will be undertaken in November and December 2024.
