Introduction

The constitution of the Jersey Council for Safety and Health at Work, an independent body set up by the States to promote the health and safety of workers, agreed by the States on the 30th July 1991 (P102), provides for the appointment of members to the Council by the Minister for Social Security.

The Council consists of a Chairman and four members who are appointed to serve a three year term of office. The Council receives an annual grant to carry out its work and is required to submit an annual report and accounts to the States.

Following a recruitment exercise to appoint to a new member to the Council, following the retirement of the previous incumbent, the Chairman of the Council selected Mr Ross Muir as the preferred choice in view of his extensive experience of working as a senior health and safety professional across a broad range of industry sectors, including construction, manufacturing and utilities.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Minister agrees to the proposal from Dr Taylor, Chairman of the Jersey Council for Safety and Health at Work, to appoint Mr Ross Muir for a 3 year term of office as a member of Council with effect from the 20 March 2023.
