Detail

In October 2024, the Government of Jersey launched a public consultation seeking feedback on draft Competition (Jersey) Amendment Law 202- which, if approved, would amend the Competition (Jersey) Law 2005.

The draft Law is intended to update Jersey's competition legislation and ensure the Island has a modern, but balanced, legal framework that is supportive to businesses and protects consumer interests. In particular, it focusses on enhancing the operation of Jersey's mergers and acquisitions regime, improving the Authority's ability to conduct market studies in a wide range of economic sectors and supporting efficient and effective enforcement in certain cases by enabling the Authority to accept legally binding 'commitments'.

The Response Paper summarises the feedback received and sets out the Government's response to the consultation.
